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LSHK Annual Research Forum: Report from hosts at EdUHK



The 2016 Annual Research Forum (ARF), was held on Saturday 3 December 2016 at The Education University of Hong Kong. The ARF was well attended with nearly three dozen talks and two special sessions: (i) The Cantonese proficiency test and language policy in Hong Kong, chaired by Dr. Caesar Lun from the City University of Hong Kong, and (ii) Cantonese writing with special reference to the development of Cantonese writing tradition in the past two centuries.

The ARF included presentations from many researchers from both home and abroad. We would like to extend a heartfelt thanks to the EdUHK local organizing committee for their time and energy making the ARF such a success!

LSHK Outstanding Thesis Awards

Two awards were presented at the 2016 Annual Research Forum for outstanding theses. Dr. Cheng Siu Pong 鄭兆邦 was given an Outstanding Thesis Award for the PhD category for his thesis entitled 香港粵語 動詞前後置成份的句法語義關係 (The relationship of syntactic and semantic aspects of postverbal particles and their preverbal counterparts in Hong Kong Cantonese). He completed his PhD at the Chinese University of Hong Kong under the supervision of Dr. Tang Sze-Wing.

Ms. Scarlet Li Wan Yee was given an Outstanding Thesis Award for the Masters category. Her thesis, *The relation of working memory, declarative memory and procedural memory as individual differences in second language acquisition*, was also completed at the Chinese University of Hong Kong under the supervision of Dr. Gloria Zhang. 




















LSHK: 2017 Fieldwork subsidy award

Workshop on Cantonese (WOC-17) a success!

The Seventeenth Annual Workshop on Cantonese (WOC-17) was held at Hong Kong Baptist University on Saturday, April 22, 2017 in the David C. Lam Building (DLB 719). WOC-17 was co-sponsored by the Linguistic Society of Hong Kong, HKBU's Department of English Language and Literature, and HKBU's Faculty of Arts. There were speakers from Hong Kong Baptist University, The Chinese University of Hong Kong, The Education University of Hong Kong, the University of Tsukuba, and the University of British Columbia. The theme of WOC-17 was "The Teaching and Learning of Cantonese as an Additional Language" and and some of the presented papers will be published in an edited volume that has been accepted for publication by Routledge, titled Cantonese as a Second Language: Issues, Experiences and Suggestions for Teaching and Learning.

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Upcoming: 22nd International Conference on Yue dialects

The 22nd International Conference on Yue dialects will be held at the **Education University of Hong Kong** on **December 8-9, 2017.** The conference is organized by EdUHK's Department of Linguistics and Modern Language Studies, and the Centre for Research on Linguistics and Language Studies. Globalization is the theme of this year's conference but all areas of linguistics related to Cantonese and other Yue dialects will be covered in the programme, with a particular focus on digital humanities and Cantonese, Cantonese teaching and learning, Cantonese literature/literary writing in Cantonese and Studies, of early Cantonese texts.

There are four keynote speakers:

- Professor Marjorie Chan: Dr. Sun Yat-sen's 1924 Cantonese speech: A small corpus-based study of contact-induced language variation.
- Professor Ching May Bo: 城市之聲「西關音」: 由省而及滬
- Professor Benjamin Tsou 從「叮噹」到「叮鈴噹啷」探索粵語與百越關係
