**Getting to the LSHK-ARF 2017 at HKBU**

**On Foot:** Take Exit A2 from the Kowloon Tong MTR. Walk straight ahead and turn left along Waterloo Road. Go about 3 blocks and cross the street at the crosswalk. Stay along the right side of Junction Road and walk up to Renfrew Road. Turn right and walk down to the Wing Lung Bank Building, which is at the first crosswalk.

**By minibus:** Take Exit D from the Kowloon Tong MTR. Take the 25M minibus, which goes to HKBU. Get off across from the Wing Lung Bank Building. If you miss that stop, then get off after it circles back around and stops at the Car Park B entrance.
